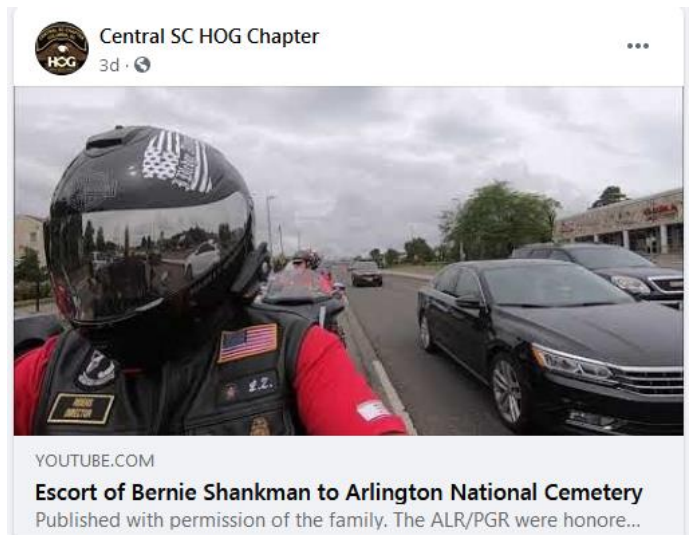
day when your day gets to start out with puppy kisses from this cutie!
