KIM'S KORNER

I've been riding Harley-Davidson motorcycles for about 12 years now. I am by no means a mechanic or "gear head". I just liked riding a Harley. When I bought my 2011 Road Glide Ultra I started to make my monthly trip in to see Ricci at Harley Haven to see what kind of chrome I would be adding to the bike that month. But as I started to ride with the HOG chapter and met guys that knew a lot more about H-D's than I did or ever will, I started to hear about Stage 1, Stage 2, etc. and had no clue what it meant but I knew I had to start adding it to my bike. Because who wants to be left behind at the stop light!

So what does all this stage talk mean to your pride and joy?

The following descriptions can be used to generally describe the various performance levels and modification for each stage:

Stage 1: these are generally considered exhaust and intake modifications to an otherwise stock engine along with the appropriate EFI Tuner. Most Stage 1 type modifications are typically in the +10-15% power increase over stock.

Stage 2: this is typically referred to an engine with a performance cam upgrade as well as the other components within a Stage 1 combination. A typical Stage 2 has generally +20-25% more HP than stock.

Stage 3: most normally refer to the Stage 3 type build as a mild big bore & cam upgrade and included the other components of the lower Stages. These kits in most cases use the stock throttle body and most of the other stock components. HP increases can be +30-40% or more from stock

Stage 4: this would be a moderate compression big bore combination. It includes headwork and more cam than a Stage 3. In many cases it would include a larger throttle body & injectors (depending on the specific model). Additional supportive mods would be required such as clutch and other upgrades. Power levels can be +50-60% or much more over stock

Stage 5: this would be a custom high compression big bore combination. It includes comprehensive headwork and aggressive cam. This requires larger throttle body & injectors as well as additional supportive mods - would be considered fuel & tune sensitive. Power levels can be +70-80% or much more over stock, in some cases even more.

So if you are ready to make that next step in upgrading your motorcycle's performance, check in with Tejay or Randy or one of the other Harley Haven technicians to get the details on taking it to the next stage in your bike's life!


If you or someone you know has a classic car, truck or motorcycle they'd like to show off, please spread the word! No trophies or awards, just enjoying the classics and camaraderie.
