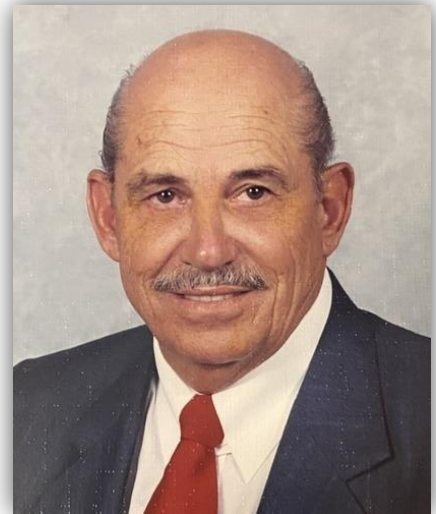
The goal is to take the child and the family away from the stress of their daily life and allow them to enjoy life for a little while.

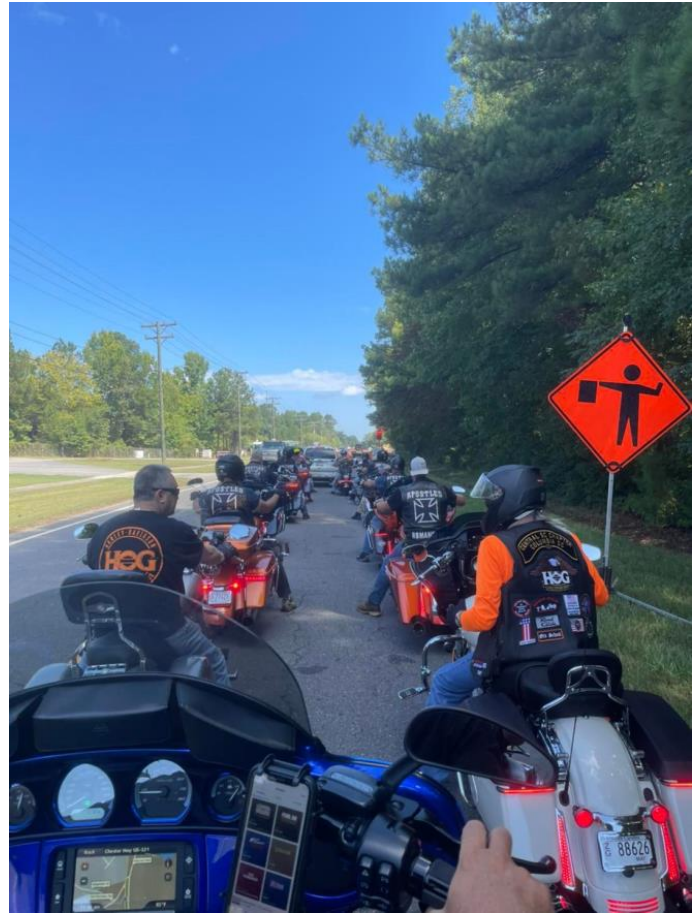


Ted Price
