

Thought some of you may be interested in how the \$8,500 was raised for Carolina Sunshine. We actually raise money all year and do one donation yearly to Carolina Sunshine.

Carolina Sunshine has no paid officers; all their Board Members are volunteers. Every dollar we donate goes to grant wishes for children with life threatening diseases.
